- 2. Large School Choir will sing the National Anthem for the Region Choir Concert.
- 3. TMEA Policy Updates
  - a. SSC Regions are free to elect their region coordinator. It's a two-year term and will be voted on in this spring meeting.
  - b. There must be members from at least two divisions serving on the Region Executive Board. Please consider serving on the board.
  - c. Please see the TMEA website for audition notes and errata. No more errata will be added after September 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - d. We are Area D for LSC. Sing the top notes in divisi.
  - e. Our area for LSC will also sing the top note in divisi.
  - f. Josh McGuire is recording the prompt for sight reading. This will be used across the state for every region audition.
  - g. Area Sight Reading be prepared for a more rigorous example. The parameters are listed on the TMEA website.
  - h. All State student fee is increasing to \$30.
  - i. Students that don't have a "host home school" (private schools, homeschools and students without a "host home school"), must participate in the largest classification in the school district they reside. Ex. Students living in Tyler would compete in LSC. You can submit a variance to TMEA to change that.
  - j. You, as the director, are responsible for reading the region handbook to find out how a contest works and the policies concerning that contest. You are also required to consult the TMEA policies.
