 - a. Chair Elect Nominations
 No nominations. Nicole Stewart will remain vocal chair for the next term.
 Motion made, seconded, & motion passes.
 - b. Discuss Honor Choir Voicing SAB to SATB- Amy McMichael Motion made to change the Honor Choir music to SATB. Rationale: when Honor Choir was formed it was strictly a 9th grade choir and was voiced SATB. This wasn't the best for our students and was changed to SAB. Then Honor Choir was opened up to all grade levels. Currently, we have so many singers auditioning

for baritone that we are close to having to split the audition room into two zones. Let's make the music more comfortable for the students by changing the "B" voicing to TB.

The motion was seconded and passed 84.6%

Motion was made to have the numbers of tenor bass voices in the Honor Choir to 15 tenors and 15 basses. Motion was seconded and passed. Honor Choir voices will be soprano – 25, alto – 25, tenor – 15, and bass – 15

- c. ALL TMEA auditions at ALL rounds will be in person and back to normal this upcoming year!
- Middle School Clinic & Concert
 Much discussion about various topics concerning middle school auditions and clinic & concert.

Discussion – Tommy Corley – Cut the length of the clinic & concert day for middle school. The choirs could rehearse in the morning, take lunch break, run through everything one more time, and then begin concerts in the early afternoon.

Survey answers – Laci Reid – Yes, the schedule for middle school clinic & concert should be revised. No, we should not add a 4th piece of music for the audition. Discussion – Joy Brooks – Add a 4th piece of music to the audition for middle school all region. Currently, the middle school clinic & concert day is too long. The clinicians have to add "games and such" to the afternoon just to kill time. If we add a 4th piece, there would be more time devoted to working on four pieces of music.

Discussion – if we change the schedule of the clinic & concert we won't need a fourth piece. Many directors were not in favor of adding a 4th piece.

Discussion – Separate high school and middle school clinic & concert. There are a lot of dates and locations to host fewer choirs for rehearsal and performance. We could have the high school clinc on a school day and a concert that evening to avoid Fridays and Saturdays.

Motion made – Separate high school and middle school clinic & concert to different days. Seconded and passed 75%

Nicole and Laci will discuss a schedule later. Laci would love middle school director input. Please send her an email with your ideas.

Motion made – Middle school uses the comparable date of November 6th and high school will find a different date. Seconded and passed.

e. Dates and Sites for 2021-2022 Contests

There was much discussion about the HS Concert and Sight-Reading date. The comparable date was listed at Tuesday-Wednesday, April 12-13. The past school year contest was on Monday-Tuesday. At this time of year different days of the week and dates work better for different school districts. Two different options were put up, April 11-12 and April 12-13. The vote was split evenly at 50/50. More discussion and a revote. With the revote, the dates of April 12-13 passed with a majority.
